



Information Gathering

Selfreflection

- Own practices, values
- Historical context

Description

- What is going on?
- Who, what, when, where, how

Explanation

- Why?
- Literature review

Self-Reflection

How did things get to be the way they are?

What do you believe about teaching and learning

Your understandings about theory and practice and school and society.

Description

Describe the situation you want to change.

Describe your evidence that there is a problem.


Identify critical factors that affect the problem.

Explanation

Explain the situation you are going to investigate

Hypothesize about what factors you think are present

Explain why you think identified factors affect the situation
